**GENERAL FUND 2018 – 2019 BUDGET WORK SESSION.**

After discussion, Frank Bannister moved to approve changing the General Fund Budget to reflect City Court being held every other month rather than every month. Motion carried.

Frank Bannister moved to budget \$2,500 for city hall contributions account with \$1,000 being earmarked for City emergencies and authorizing the Mayor not to exceed \$100 for any one event without Council's consent and that no contribution exceed \$250. Motion carried.

Steve Hanna moved to place a line item under Culture and Recreation to reflect a donation of \$3,000 to the Hogue House. Joe Rumbaugh abstained. Motion carried.

Kevin Karnes made a motion to increase the Fire Department donation from \$ 1,750 to \$ 5,000. Ryan Powers abstained. Motion carried.

Ryan Powers moved to approve the General Fund budget for 2018-2019 with the above additions and changes. Motion carried.

**2018– 2019 COAL SEVERANCE PROPOSED BUDGET:**

Frank Bannister moved to accept the proposed 2018-2019 Coal Severance budget as presented. Motion carried.
